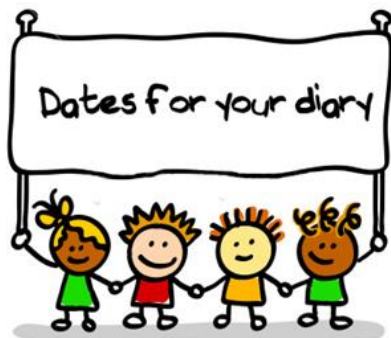
Attendance
