EXCLUSION POLICY

Governors will be asked to consider exclusion for the following reasons:

1. Persistent inappropriate/anti-social behaviour reported through hierarchical system to the Headteacher.
 - Parents have been involved, but no improvement.
 - Danger to self or others.
 - Constant flouting of school rules.
 - No response to behavioural sanctions.

2. Severe, immediate cases:
 - Severe radical abuse/harassment.
 - Unprovoked attack(s) on other children leading to significant injury/hurt.
 - Assault with a weapon.
 - Significant, deliberate vandalism or destruction of school property.
 - Assault on a member of staff.
 - Complete refusal to obey any reasonable instructions/requests.

The Headteacher will follow the LA's exclusion policy and guidelines and will adhere to the agreed procedures.
