

GLYNNE PRIMARY SCHOOL SNOW POLICY



In the event of the Local Authority not making a blanket decision, the decision to close school will be at the Headteacher's and Chair of Governors' discretion.

The following procedure will be followed:

- School will review the weather situation first thing in the morning (7am)
- If a decision is taken to close, information will be given to *local radio stations, a text message will be sent to parents via Group Call and a notice will be posted on our website.

- If there is snow or very icy conditions and school decides to remain open, access arrangements will be as follows:
 - Entry will be through the main entrance off Cot Lane or via Pleasant Close through the Nursery entrance
 - FLY and KS1 parents may accompany children to their classrooms
 - **Kingswood gate will not be open**
 - At the end of the day access to school for parents will be via the same entrances and parents will collect all children directly from classrooms unless a child normally walks home alone
 - School will remain open until the end of the school day; however, if weather conditions deteriorate through the course of the day parents may collect children early if necessary.

*Local radio – Heart FM, Beacon Radio and BRMB
