Please complete at least one of the following tasks and bring it into school by Friday 10th March.

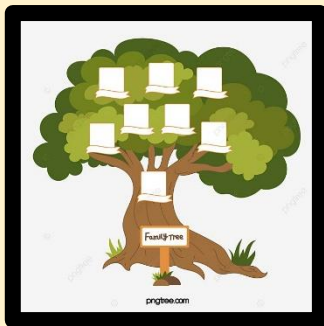
Remember it's okay to work with your family members to create your take home task.

What is Germany like as a country today?

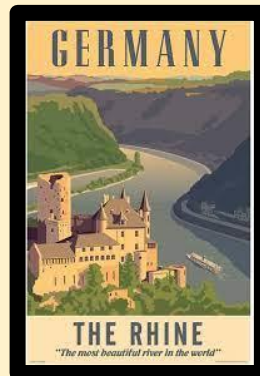
What are the key cities?

Think about the human and physical geography of Germany.

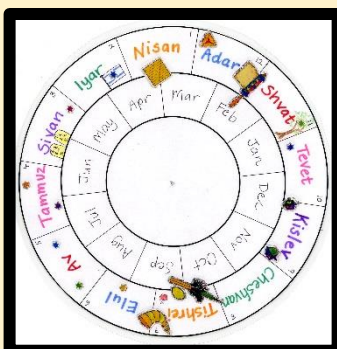
What is Germany famous for?
