As Scientists

Make a scientific model of a volcano. How can you make your design look realistic? Will you label key features of your volcano? Or will you combine it with your science skills to make it erupt using chemical reactions?



You can bring your model in, photograph it, or even take a video of the volcanic eruption for us to watch.

As Digital Creators

Create an animation that shows something evolving from one thing to another.

You can do this by using:

- Stop motion
- Using J2E animate (on J2E - JIT)
- Coding on Scratch



As DT Masters

Design, make and evaluate your own fossil cookies. You could even create different flavours and get people in your family to taste tests them to see which is the most popular. You may also design and make packaging for your product to go in.



As Mathematicians

Combine your Science and mathematical skills; collect data from a garden or park about the nature you observe. Present your results creatively in a variety of ways e.g., table, bar chart, pictogram, line graph, pie chart etc.

Write mathematical statements about the results including fractions, percentages, and the mean.
