### Support for Families

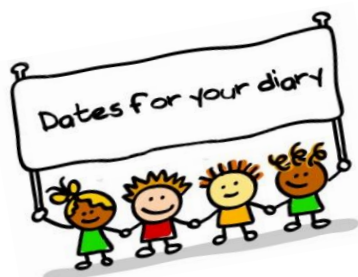
