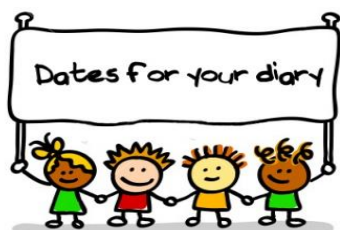
Safeguarding is all about us working together to make sure that children, young people and adults are safe and protected. Safeguarding is everyone's responsibility.
